In the season of COVID-19 you're invited to pass the peace of God however and to whoever you can this day as we live our lives of disciples of Jesus sheltering-in-place, as a living sign of the Dominion of God at work moving us toward the healing transformation of the world.

OUR NEW NORMAL AT CAPC OAKLAND

CAPC Oakland will be restarting in-person worship on Sunday, June 27th at 10:30am. This is a decision made by the Elders of our Session (our elected governing board) as per their responsibility for the well-being of our community.

BUT WHAT DOES THAT LOOK LIKE?

IF YOU COME IN PERSON PLEASE WEAR A MASK AND COME READY FOR FUN -

Upon arriving at church you'll be welcomed by greeters and asked to sign-in (or they'll sign you in) before entering the sanctuary. This will allow us to keep an accurate list should we need to do any contact tracing. We ask that you wear a face mask to be sensitive to those who have not yet been vaccinated. We're thinking in particular of our under 12 years of age children who do not qualify yet for the vaccine. If you don't have a mask with you, we'll have them (as well as plenty of hand sanitizer and gloves) if you need them. We will ask that you wear your mask during the service, especially when singing. Our worship leadership will model mask-wearing, but will not be wearing masks when speaking or leading song. We'll let you sit where you would like to in the church, allowing people to social distance if and how they feel they need to. We will encourage those who haven't been vaccinated to sit in the balcony to help better protect themselves. Medical experts tells us that once vaccinated we are very nearly completely safe from becoming infected with COVID-19 and also safe from transmitting it to someone else. If you are not vaccinated you will be at a higher risk and we strongly encourage you to wear a mask if you come.

COFFEE HOUR AFTER WORSHIP OUTSIDE IN THE GARDEN -

We will be having coffee hour outside in the garden for the coming summer months. We'll install chairs and seating to make things comfortable. Those who are hosting coffee hour will serve you any and all food and drinks. We ask that you allow yourself to be served in this way as a precaution. Doing so helps us to be intentionally hygienic and also will put others at ease.

FOR THOSE WHO MIGHT NOT FEEL SAFE COMING IN PERSON -

We'll be doing a hybrid service, still streaming the service via Zoom for those who wish to attend that way. So whether you come in person or stay at home you'll have the same basic experienced.

⁹ For this reason, since the day we heard it, we have not ceased praying for you and asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of God's will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, ¹⁰ so that you may lead lives worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him, as you bear fruit in every good work and as you grow in the knowledge of God. ¹¹ May you be made strong with all the strength that comes from his glorious power, and may you be prepared to endure everything with patience, while joyfully ¹² giving thanks to the Father, who has enabled you to share in the inheritance of the saints in the light. ¹³ He has rescued us from the power of darkness and transferred us into the kingdom of his beloved Son, ¹⁴ in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.
